



Presentation Boxes





A charge of £2.95 is made for each box. Please advise when placing your order.



























































Space for one first name and one date (especially long names may be a problem – please contact us if you are not sure)



Lace Groups and Organisations

We are often asked to make a larger order of the same bespoke design to commemorate the anniversaries of lace groups and organisations. If your lace group or organisation would like to order a special bobbin to commemorate an anniversary or a special occasion please contact us with an idea of the details that you might like on the bobbin and a rough idea of the number of bobbins you might require. We will then be happy to discuss your requirements and give you a price. We are also happy to undertake logos and emblems but the success of these depends on whether the design will lend itself well to the engraving process.

If you're in any doubt about what ideas might be possible or how much space is available for inscriptions etc, please contact us.

If you have a particular date for which you require your bobbins to be ready, then the sooner you can contact us with your requirements the more likely it is that we can have it ready for you in good time for the special date. Please bear in mind that at present we have a waiting list of approximately six months.

Placing an Order and Making Payment

Guarantee & Returns Policy

- 1) You may cancel your order at anytime within the first 14 days of placing your order.
- 2) If you wish to cancel your order after this time please contact us as soon as possible and we shall endeavour to meet your request. Please be aware that all bobbins are made to order once an order has entered the production process (usually 21 days prior to despatch date) it may not be cancelled.
- 3) Notification of faulty goods should be made within three days of the goods being received. All goods supplied by us are subject to production tolerances and are warranted as being suitable for the purpose for which they are designed, under fair conditions. Our liability under this warranty will be limited to the replacement and free repair against goods acknowledged by us to be faulty, providing such faults have not been caused by your misuse, negligent handling or improper care of the goods.
- 4) If you do need to return any goods, please remember to wrap the package securely as it may not be possible to offer a refund or replacement on goods which have been damaged in transit.

Bobbin-a-Month Club

How it Works

The Bobbin-a-Month Club is designed for people who would like to start or expand their own collection of Archer bobbins but would prefer to spread the cost at a level of their choice. It is also a convenient way for existing customers to increase their collection with regular deliveries of bobbins throughout the year.

All that's required is a minimum order of twelve bobbins. You may distribute your bobbins in any way you wish, two one month and one the next for example. With postage and packing free on both national and international orders, membership of the Bobbin-a-Month Club is a cost-effective way to build your bobbin collection.

Every month when we send your bobbin(s) we will also enclose a payment request slip for the following month's order. You can either send payment in the form of a pounds sterling cheque or complete and return the credit card payment form that will be attached to your request slip. We accept MasterCard and Visa.

Pricing Policy for Bobbin-a-Month Club orders

Any Bobbin-a-Month Club orders that bridge the price review on January 1st each year will benefit from receiving the first 3 month's orders of the New Year at the previous year's prices.

About A R. Archer Ltd



A R Archer takes its name from my father Anthony Archer. An accomplished and much respected craftsman, he spent many years making furniture before then making the slightly unusual transition to becoming a maker of chess sets. These he sold around the world but, being before the days of the world wide web, getting known was an expensive and far trickier affair than it is today. It was during these years that he learnt the fine turning skills that would later serve him so well as a bobbin maker.

He turned his talents to bobbin making in the late 1970's after a chance enquiry from a customer in his shop. Within three months of making his first wooden bobbin he had to start a waiting list and to this day the waiting list has remained a necessary evil. It was shortly after this time he embarked on making his first bone bobbin. Within a relatively short period of time the demand for bone bobbins far outstripped that of the wooden bobbins and turning to the exclusive production of bone bobbins the business was in need of an extra pair of hands. It was at this time that my mother Susan Archer joined the business and took on the role of preparing the bone blanks and then painting the engraved bobbins. By the mid 1980's there was a waiting list of two years and the only way of hoping to get a bobbin sooner was to find them at one of the half dozen or so lace days they attended every year. I know these were times that both my mother and father thoroughly enjoyed but sadly in 1990 my father was diagnosed with a terminal illness which left him unable to work with almost immediate effect.

It was at this time that I stepped into the breach and took on the rather daunting challenge of working to my father's standards. I had grown up around the tools of his workshop and when I left school I spent many a happy hour being taught the finer points of turning. In the last couple of years of his life he taught me the skill of freehand engraving which, little did we realise then, was rather sadly in the nick of time. We were fortunate that my father was with us for a further year and in this time I also had the benefit of being able to use him as the ultimate quality control for my work. In early 1991 my father died and I carried on the business as a partnership with my mother until the mid 1990's when she decided it was time to hang up her paint brush and devote more time to her life long passion of gardening.

I now run the business on my own albeit with a helping hand from my wife Vicky who keeps on top of the administration for me. Over the past I7 years I am proud to say that I have increased the range from some 70 bobbins when I took on the business to over 200 designs in this catalogue. I like to think that I do justice to the much respected work of my father and follow in his tradition of combining quality with innovative design - not to mention the element of fun that appears in some designs of which I know he would have whole heartedly approved.

Another aspect of the business that has changed is the waiting list. A two year wait was, I felt, an unreasonable amount of time to ask people to be patient so it was with reluctance that we gave up attending lace days and used the time saved to cut the waiting list. This did have a beneficial effect but it was only with the introduction of the Bobbin-a-Month Club in the late nineties that it was brought down to the more sensible three to six months where it currently stands.

I hope this brief history of the business is of interest - over recent years I've been contacted by a growing number of people seeking to know more due to an increasing level of interest in Archer bobbins on internet auction sites. I thought therefore that this would be a good opportunity to explain how Archer bobbins came about, who my father was and how I fit into the picture.
